Tricia maintained the 3 hit margin over Kathy to the end as the two tied on hits on the shorted distances, Judy dropped 2 shots at 50 which would prove decisive at the end of the day, despite matching on hits and getting the highest score at 40 yards.

Fang, while getting one less hit over 50 and 40 yards, put up the best score at 50 yards

and was only being beaten by Judy at 40 yards, scores assisted in no small part by the number of Golds she had.

It was a very close match with the top 3 scores separated by just 3 points and the top 3 overall separated by 3 hits.

It was Tricia, who maintained her advantage to go on and take first place, Congratulations.
